ARRIVAL INFORMATION

ACCESS CODES / INSTRUCTIONS

Your unique access code will unlock the front door to the house. Press the four-digit code then press “Lockstate” to unlock. When leaving, press the “Lockstate” button to lock the door. Please make sure that the sliding glass and garage doors are locked to ensure the house is secure.

For your security, we will always email access codes separately.

CHECK-IN TIME

Check-in time is 4pm. If another guest has checked out on your arrival day, there is a short timeframe that we need for the cleaning crew to prepare the house for your stay. We can sometimes arrange an early check-in so please contact us if you will arrive early and we'll do our best, without any promises! We suggest you refer to the section on what to do if you arrive early - there is plenty to keep you entertained on the island!

DRIVING DIRECTIONS

GETTING HERE WITHOUT A CAR

We understand that some of you will be traveling without a car. In this case finding us is pretty simple! If arriving from the airport or ferry, you can take a taxicab or Uber/Lyft and they will get you to 95 Tom Nevers Road.

The house is located on a shared driveway and we are the second home on the left after the right turn off of Tom Nevers Road.

CONCIERGE SERVICE

95 Tom Nevers is equipped with a Virtual Concierge Service using the Amazon Echo Show. When you arrive at the house, simply say, “**Alexa, Check In**” (on the second level) and you can interact with the Virtual Concierge. Refer to the section in this document for Virtual Concierge to learn more about how the Alexa Virtual Concierge can assist you.

IMPORTANT: The Alexa Show device has a video camera privacy switch that covers the lens of the video camera. This privacy switch will protect from anyone being able to view inside the house. Only if you request a video chat with the owner should you switch off the privacy switch.

PARKING

Parking is provided on site for up to 3 cars. The garage is not available for parking as we keep our Jeep there for when we are on island.

SECURITY

For your safety and the security of the home, there are outside security cameras that are accessed by the security company in the event of a reported issue. There are no inside video cameras (except for the Echo Show which is mentioned earlier in this section.)

When you leave the house, please lock all external doors (Sliding door on deck, garage door in laundry room and front door.) While crime is extremely rare on Nantucket, the owners cannot be responsible for lost or stolen items during your stay.

SHOES

Please remove hard soled shoes whenever you enter the house. There is a bench in the foyer to assist with shoe removal and a place under the bench to store shoes. The floors and stairs are particularly vulnerable to being marked up by hard soled shoes. Also, sand is not a friend to our hardwood floors that have recently been installed.

DEPARTURE INFORMATION

CHECK-OUT PROCESS

When you leave, please ensure the following simple tasks are done:

- take the trash and recycling outside to the bins
- ensure the windows and doors are closed and the air-conditioning is set to 75F
- Strip beds and place linens in the laundry room (cleaners will take care of laundry)
- run the dishwasher (if there are dirty dishes)
- clean the grill/bbq (if you used it)
- lock the house

CHECK-OUT TIME

Check-out time is strictly 10am. Should you require a later check-out we will do our best to accommodate you but you need to let us know beforehand. If we have guests arriving that day it will be almost impossible to offer a late check-out due to the cleaners needing to prepare for those guests.


CLEANING

You will find the house clean on arrival but please let us know if you are not satisfied. There is no cleaning service during your stay. The cleaners have their own code and will only enter the house after 10am on the day of your departure. If you would like cleaning during your stay, please let us know in advance and we can arrange it. An extra payment will apply. On departure it would be helpful if you would leave the house (particularly kitchen contents and bbq/grill) clean and tidy.


GETTING YOURSELF ORIENTED

OVERVIEW OF THE AREA

Tom Nevers is a residential area in the Southeast corner of Nantucket. We are located about 6 miles from downtown and about 3 miles from the airport.



A short walk from the house (.25 miles) is Tom Nevers field and a quiet beach called Pebble Beach. Also very close to the house is Tom Nevers Beach at access location 31B. Please respect the other residences in the area and remain on public roads to access these beaches.



SUGGESTIONS IF YOU ARRIVE EARLY

Many guests will arrive before the designated check-in time of 4PM. The good news is that there is plenty to do on Nantucket Island. We often suggest that guests visit the grocery store and purchase essentials so you will have more time to relax once you've checked in. There are also a few good restaurants for lunch so you can relax and enjoy some of the local food! Check out the recommendations section for some dining ideas.

Downtown Nantucket is a quaint New England village with many small shops and boutiques that are must do's sometime during your visit. Just wandering the cobblestone streets and exploring the sights is a fun experience in itself!

AIR CONDITIONING

Our home has the benefit of air conditioning. You will find one thermostat at the top of the stairs for the main level and another thermostat in the master bedroom for the downstairs. **IMPORTANT:** Please ensure that **all windows and outside doors** are closed while the AC is running to ensure it operates to maximum efficiency. We recommend a setting of 72-74F which we find keeps the house sufficiently cool and comfortable.

CENTRAL HEATING

Our home has a central heating system. You will find one thermostat at the top of the stairs for the main level and another thermostat in the master bedroom for the downstairs. We recommend a setting of 66-68F which we find keeps the house sufficiently warm.

KITCHEN EQUIPMENT

Our home is fully equipped with all necessary appliances for your convenience. All operating manuals are posted on our website for access. You can view these manuals at: <https://ackvacations.biz/manuals>.

The Dishwasher:

It's very simple, we promise! We provide a supply of tablets for your use. The dishwasher is a dual-drawer model which runs two half-loads either independently or at the same time. Always check that spinning arms can move freely before starting the dish washing cycle. Then press the program button of your choice - there are a few settings which are obvious - then press the start button. There is also a delay option to have the dishwasher run after you go to sleep.

The Fridge/freezer:

You should not need to adjust any settings. If you run into any difficulties (e.g. it's not cooling efficiently) please let us know. The ice maker in the freezer is active but you may want to purchase ice at the store for an extra supply.

The Stove & Oven:

The range is a four-burner gas stove with an electric oven. The control panel should be “locked” when not in use to avoid inadvertently turning on the stove or oven. To lock, simply hold the Start button for three seconds until you hear a beep. To unlock, follow the same steps.

COFFEE & TEA

The drink area in the kitchen is equipped with a dual mode coffee maker (for brewing a full pot or individual cups). Slide the tray forward from under the cabinet to use the coffee maker. Coffee filters are located in the cabinet for brewing a pot. The single brew option uses Keurig K-cups. To use this option, **only pour a measured coffee mug** of water into the reservoir – overfilling will cause spillage!

There is also an electric water heater for making tea or cocoa.



LAUNDRY APPLIANCES

We have a washer and separate dryer located in the laundry room off the downstairs foyer. There is a supply of detergent for your use. To operate the machines, simply select the program you want, place the detergent in the tray, close the door, and hit start. Please **clean the lint trap** for the dryer after every use. GAS FIREPLACE

The gas fireplace is available for use in the off-peak season. During the summer months, (July and August) the fireplace is turned off and should not be used.

To start the fireplace, use the remote control on the living room coffee table. The ON switch will start the fire and the thermostat button should be set to the “smart” setting which will adjust the fire to maintain an even temperature in the room.



ENJOYING YOUR TIME INSIDE

BOARD GAMES / PLAYING CARDS / READING

There is a selection of games on the shelf in the living room. There is a selection of books and magazines throughout the house.

BREAKAGES

We understand that sometimes accidents happen! Should you break anything please let us know immediately - if it's minor we usually won't charge. If it's a larger issue we would like to agree on the cost with you before you leave to avoid any issues later. Thank you!

MUSIC SYSTEM

The Alexa system can be used for playing music. To stream from your phone, tablet or laptop, say "Alexa, Bluetooth pairing" and follow the instructions.

TELEVISION / DVD SYSTEM

The televisions in the house are equipped with Roku streaming devices. Live TV is provided using the xFinity streaming app for Roku. To activate, install the Xfinity streaming app and use the following credentials:

Make sure that the upstairs soundbar is turned on to get sound (amber light means its on). Other viewing options include Hulu, Netflix, Amazon Prime, Apple+, Tubi and Vudu (utilizing your own accounts). When activating Roku, select the last full date you will be staying and the Roku systems will automatically reset and erase any account information you may have entered on that date.

DINING IN

The house is fully equipped for dining in. There are plates, bowls, and utensils located in the butler's pantry in the dining area. Glassware and mugs are located in the kitchen cabinets. The dining table seats 6 but there are two additional chairs in the downstairs bedrooms to seat up to 8 people.

If you don't want to cook, there are many restaurants that will provide take out or delivery service. See the recommended restaurants in the back of this guide or login to **ACKEATS.COM** or **DELIVERY.COM** to place an online order with a nominal delivery charge.

ENJOYING YOUR TIME OUTSIDE

BEACH EQUIPMENT

Beach chairs, portable cabana, and beach toys are located in the garage. Please wash sand off these items before storing them back in the garage.

BEACH TOWELS

There are striped beach towels available for use in the linen closet on the first level. Please do **NOT** use our white towels for the beach! These are expensive towels that will be damaged from the sand. Thank you for your consideration.

GRILL / BBQ

There is a gas grill on the deck outside the sliding glass door. The gas valve (by the house) needs to be turned on before starting the grill and then turned off after use. Grilling tools should be located under the grill but may get moved to the kitchen by other guests. Please remove the plastic grill cover before starting the grill and after use, please clean the grill and *once it is cooled*, replace the plastic cover. OUTDOOR SHOWER

We have an outdoor shower on the side of the house by the garage. This is a useful way to wash off sand and salt after a day at the beach without tracking it into the house.

DINING OUT

Nantucket is very much a “foodie” town with almost every culinary style represented. During the peak season, we recommend making reservations **before** coming to the island as some restaurants will book full very quickly. There is a list of our favorite restaurants later in this guide.

PLEASE NOTE: Some restaurants may not reopen following the loss of business in 2020 due to the pandemic. Please contact the restaurants you wish to visit to determine whether they are open and have seating availability.

OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

BED LINEN / TOWELS

All of the beds at 95 Tom Nevers will be freshly made and ready for use when you arrive. Each bed will also have a basket with clean towels and wash cloths for use. Feel free to use the washer/dryer if you need to launder these items during your stay.

GARBAGE DISPOSAL & RECYCLING

95 Tom Nevers has a septic system and therefore **does not have a garbage disposal**. Please do not put garbage into the sink drain. There is further information regarding trash and recycling in the next section.

WINDOWS & DOORS

Be aware of open windows and doors! Nantucket weather changes very quickly and a rain shower can easily bring unwanted water into the house and damage the walls and floors. When you leave the house during your stay, please close all external windows and doors. If you notice any leakage after a rainstorm, please notify us immediately. Our caretaker will assess the problem and make any necessary repairs.

For safety reasons, only open the top half of the loft window if necessary for fresh air.

SHOES & FLOOR CARE

Please remove hard soled shoes whenever entering the house. The stairs and hardware floors are easily scuffed with hard soled shoes. Also, please clean up any spillage or sand on the floors immediately to avoid damage from these items. There is a vacuum cleaner in the closet under the stairway for your use.

WHERE TO FIND THINGS:

- **Utility Closet Under Stairs:** Cleaning tools and supplies
- **Under Kitchen Sink:** Dishwasher Soap, Trash Bags (clear), cleaners
- **Laundry Room:** Detergents, ironing board, iron, steamer, plunger and extra toilet tissue (above steel cabinet)
- **Linen Closet:** Extra linens, bath and beach towels

VIRTUAL CONCIERGE

Your Virtual Concierge will assist you with answering many of your questions and planning your activities on Nantucket Island. Simply say, "Alexa, Virtual Assistant" to activate and you will be prompted for questions. Your Concierge will try to answer your question and if she cannot, your question will be logged for future guests so the Concierge will get smarter over time!

SAFETY INFORMATION & RENTAL RULES

RULES & REGULATIONS

TRASH AND RECYCLING

Nantucket has a strict recycling policy that must always be adhered to.

There are *six types of waste* that must be separated for pickup. The pickup bins are located outside of the garage where there are five bins labelled for each type of trash (shipping containers/cardboard should be broken flat for placed in the same area as the trash bins.

There are five containers in the kitchen/dining area to make this separation as simple as possible. To the left of the sink there is a pull-out trash drawer with two containers. The front container is for **compostable** trash and the rear container is for **non-compostable** trash. At the bottom of the ladder to the loft there are three recycling bins that are labelled for plastics, tin/aluminum, and glass. These bins should be emptied into the matching outdoor bins for trash pickup.

Trash is picked up on Tuesday mornings and Friday mornings each week during the summer (July and August) and Tuesday mornings each week in the off season.

Also, be advised that Nantucket has instituted a ban on single use plastics for commercial use. This means that businesses will not be using or selling the following products on the island:



PET POLICY

Unless special arrangements have been made with us, no pets may be kept at the house at any time.

SMOKING POLICY

There is no smoking allowed at 95 Tom Nevers – inside or outside - at any time. There is risk to starting a brush fire if this policy is not followed.

Violations of these policies will result in the termination of the rental agreement and forfeiture of the damage deposit to provide additional cleaning of the house.

SAFETY INFORMATION

EMERGENCY EXIT INSTRUCTIONS

95 Tom Nevers is equipped with both smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. In the event of an alarm, please proceed to an exit as quickly as possible and contact the fire department at 911 or (508) 228-2323. All first-floor bedrooms can be exited through a window if necessary. Sleepers in the loft should exit down the ladder and through the sliding door on the deck.

EMERGENCY PHONE NUMBERS

For emergency services please immediately call 911. Do not delay if you feel an emergency situation has arisen.

LOCATION OF FIRE EXTINGUISHER

There is a fire extinguisher located in the kitchen on the beam to the left of the stove/oven.

LOCATION OF GAS SHUT-OFF VALVE

The gas shutoff for the house is located outside by the entrance to the outdoor shower.

LOCATION OF ELECTRIC PANEL

If power is lost to a portion of the house, check the power panels to see if a circuit was tripped. There are two panels, one in the laundry room and a second on the far wall of the garage.

FIRST AID

There are two first aid kits - one in the Laundry room on the first level and one under the kitchen sink.

LOCAL CONDITIONS

STAYING SAFE ADVICE

Rip Currents

Rip Currents are the major cause of surf accidents. They are characterized by a strong flow of water rushing back out to sea. Rip currents occur when large amounts of water accumulate near shore due to natural wave action. Since water seeks its own level, the broken waves take the path of least resistance. This powerful flow of water can pull even strong swimmers into deep water. Generally, the size and strength of the rip currents are in proportion to the size and frequency of the wave action - the larger the waves, the stronger the rip currents. Depending on lateral currents, rip currents can be fixed at one location or can occur at more than one point along the beach. Large rip currents can be recognized by the sandy discoloration of the water.

Backwash

Backwash usually occurs with high tides on beaches that rise sharply away from the water's edge. Backwash occurs when the water remaining on the beach returns forcefully to the surf beneath later incoming waves. It is particularly dangerous for small children playing near the water's edge. Even in the short distance between breaking waves and deep water, backwash is powerful enough to knock people off their feet.

Lateral Currents

Lateral Currents flow parallel to the beach. They range in speed from fast-flowing to subtle movement. These currents pose little threat to the average swimmer, but weaker swimmers can be pulled into rip currents and heavy surf simply by the force of lateral currents.

Shore Break

Shore Break can occur at high tide when heavy surf conditions cause large waves to break on the beach with little or no water under them. Shore break can be particularly dangerous to a swimmer who is caught in such a wave because the wave can slam the swimmer on the beach, causing injury. Shore break is the most frequent cause of serious back, neck and shoulder injuries at the beach. Avoid body surfing during shore break conditions.

Beach Access Location Number

When you arrive at the beach - note your Beach Access Location Number which will be posted at the beach entrance. In case of emergency, when calling for assistance, give the operator this Beach Access Location Number so emergency vehicles can find you quickly.

Whistle Alerts

Long Whistle: Emergency, Exit the water

Short Whistles: Lifeguard needs your attention, Follow directions.

Beach Rules & Regulations

- Take direction from lifeguards at all times
- Floatation devices allowed at lifeguard's discretion
- No un-leashed dogs are allowed
- No fishing
- No kite flying
- No vehicles allowed
- No open fires
- No alcohol
- No beach holes deeper than your waist. Please fill in your hole before you leave.

General Info

- Never swim alone - use the buddy system.
- Don't overestimate your swimming ability, especially early in the summer when the water is cold. Swimming ability is severely decreased in cold water.
- Judge your ability to participate in beach activities based on your swimming skills without the assistance of rafts and other flotation devices.
- Never dive into shallow water, or water of unknown depth.
- If you are confronted by a large wave and there is not enough time to get away from it, try to dive underneath the wave. Keep your body as low as possible until the wave passes over you. Timing is important, dive into the base of the wave just before it breaks. Do not dive if the water is too shallow - instead crouch and keep a low body profile.
- If caught in rip currents, relax and swim toward the shore at a 45-degree angle until you are free of the current. If the rip currents are strong, swim parallel with the shoreline in the same direction as the littoral current and then swim diagonally toward the shore. If you are not able to swim out of the currents, call or wave for help.
- When body surfing, do not ride waves in a straight line toward shore. Instead, surf at an angle to the waves. Stay away from the white water in the wave center to avoid going "over the falls."
- Never swim while intoxicated. Alcohol impairs judgement, unnecessary risks are taken and a swimmer will tire more easily, increasing the chance of an accident.

RENTAL CARS

DRIVING ON NANTUCKET

Nantucket does not have any stoplights but we do have a few rotaries. When entering the rotary it is expected that a vehicle in the rotary has the right of way. Also, be on the lookout for frequent sightings of deer, bunnies, and bicyclists! There are several places where the bike paths cross over the streets so please be aware of pedestrians and cyclists at these intersections.

2. TAKE THE SCONSET BLUFF WALK

ONCE YOU'VE BIKED DOWN TO SCONSET, YOU CAN'T SKIP THE BLUFF WALK.

THIS IS AN ADORABLE WALKING PATH MADE FROM WHITE SEASHELLS, THAT MEANDERS LEISURELY AROUND THE VILLAGE AND QUAIN T HOMES OF THE AREA.

START RIGHT AFTER 21 FRONT STREET, HEAD UP ON THE WALKWAY AND ENJOY ALL THE BEAUTIFUL COTTAGES! THE GREY SHINGLED HOMES THAT LINE SCONSET BLUFF WALK ARE INCREDIBLE – IVY WRAPPED WALLS, CIRCULAR TRELLISES AND FLOWERS EVERYWHERE!

ALSO NEARBY IS SCONSET BEACH, WHICH IS A CHILL, PRETTY EMPTY BEACH, AND SCONSET MARKET, A NICE LOCAL FARMER'S MARKET WHERE YOU CAN PICK UP SOME SANDWICHES, HOMEMADE GRANOLA AND PASTRIES FOR A SNACK. THERE'S ALSO A SUNSET OPTION WITH OYSTERS –MHMM.

YOU CAN ALSO RENT A DEDICATED CHARTER FROM NANTUCKET HARBOR FOR BIG GAME FISH, LIKE TUNA, MARLIN AND MAHI MAHI. I'VE ALWAYS WANTED TO TRY THAT AFTER WATCHING TOO MANY EPISODES OF WICKED TUNA!

6. VISIT THE WHALING MUSEUM

IF IT HAPPENS TO RAIN DURING YOUR TRIP TO NANTUCKET, A PERFECT INDOOR ACTIVITY IS TO VISIT THE WHALING MUSEUM. IT'S LOCATED IN DOWNTOWN NANTUCKET, RIGHT ACROSS FROM JUICE BAR (GET AN ICE CREAM CONE WHILE YOU'RE AT IT!)

FUN FACT: HERMAN MELVILLE WAS A NANTUCKET TOURIST AND WROTE MOBY DICK LOOSELY BASED ON HIS ISLAND EXPERIENCE.

7. HAVE A CLAM BAKE

BRANT POINT LIGHTHOUSE: THIS IS THE CLOSEST LIGHTHOUSE TO TOWN, SO IT'S THE PERFECT SPOT TO WATCH SUNRISE OR SUNSET. GET AN ICE CREAM CONE FROM THE SPOT, JUICE BAR, THEN WALK DOWN TO THE LIGHTHOUSE. YOU'LL RECOGNIZE IT BY THE WHITE WALKWAY AND AMERICAN FLAG PAINTED ON ITS SIDE.

WE FIRST TRIED SOME OF THE DIFFERENT BEERS ON TAP. ONE OF THE MOST POPULAR IS THE GREY LADY BEER WITH A SHOT OF BLUEBERRY VODKA. I TRIED THE WATERMELON BASIL SANGRIA WHICH WAS DELICIOUS AND NOT TOO SWEET. THERE'S A COUPLE DIFFERENT FOOD TRUCKS PARKED AROUND, AND WE EACH ORDERED A MIX OF LOBSTER ROLLS, CRAB LEGS, DEEP-FRIED MAC & CHEESE EGG ROLLS AND SWEET POTATO FRIES TO SHARE.

AFTERWARDS, WE SIGNED UP FOR A TOUR! CISCO HAS AN ONSITE WINERY AND DISTILLERY SO IN ADDITION TO BEER THEY PRODUCE FLAVORED VODKAS, WHISKEYS AND WINE. SOME BEERS ARE ONLY AVAILABLE ON THE ISLAND, LIKE ISLAND RESERVE.

YOU SHOULDN'T SKIP THIS SPOT – IT'S PERFECT FOR FAMILIES SINCE THERE'S LIVE MUSIC AND DOGS ARE ALLOWED. CISCO OFFERS A FREE SHUTTLE FROM TOWN OR YOU CAN BIKE YOUR WAY!

10. LAY OUT ON THE BEACH

PRETTY MUCH EVERYWHERE ALONG THE COAST IS A STUNNING BEACH AND ALL OF NANTUCKET'S WATERS ARE OPEN TO THE PUBLIC. BUT, YOU PROBABLY WANT A LIFEGUARD ON DUTY, EASY ACCESS TO ROADS AND CLEAN BATHROOMS, SO YOU'LL FIND MOST PEOPLE LIKE A COUPLE OF SPOTS.
